### The following conditions will apply for the workshops/tutorials:

- Workshop room reservations
  - A number of Workshop rooms have been reserved at the hotel.  
The workshop holder must confirm their booking of one of these workshop rooms directly with the hotel.
  - Unconfirmed reservations will be cancelled January 5, 2020.
  - The workshop holder must contact the hotel directly to confirm a reservation. First come first served.
  - The workshop holder takes over all contact with the hotel regarding the workshop room once they confirm a reservation. This includes all responsibilities like cancellation, requirements, invoice, etc.
- Costs for WS holders
  - The WS holder is responsible for all hotel costs (WS-room, food, coffee) and any required equipment (NOK 635,-) incl. VAT per person will be charged for the WS-room with coffee and lunch - for a full day, given a minimum of 10 participants. For fewer participants please contact the hotel directly.)  
(Every WS room will have a projector, white-board and flip-over. If additional mains electricity extension is required for potential multiple WS-PCs or other equipment, please notify the Hotel directly)
  - There will be no added cost from the FPGA-forum committee.
- Workshop restrictions
  - The workshop holder is free to define their own registration and workshop terms.
